

2021/2022 APPROVED GRANTS

Throughout both the 2020 calendar year, and the 2020/2021 academic year, we all experienced new and different things. In many cases, it is equally appropriate to state that we did <u>NOT</u>, experience new and different things. For the 2020/2021 academic year, the Foundation had approved in excess of \$115,000 in program grant funding.

Due to COVID restrictions, clearly 12 approved grant projects, and \$31,573.02 could not be accessed. As such, the Foundation Board of Directors approved the "roll-over" of previously approved grants, to allow staff and students to participate in these learning opportunities.

COVID restrictions further impacted many programs and projects supported through the Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program (an additional, \$66,598).

In addition too these "roll-over" grants, the Wildcat Foundation approved \$20,922.45 in support of nine wholly new programs and projects for the 2021/2022 academic year.
